*Greg Hetrick* told the Board the fire department does not have access to the AEDs placed in police cruisers with the decrease in police force coverage. He stated there is a big time lapse now in response to cardiac arrest calls.

Linda Lightner felt there were major issues with the missed police calls. She asked what the plan is for the police in Greenfield Township.

Roger Lingenfelter felt the PA State Police backup coverage would not be able to come for most calls in townships; especially cardiac arrest calls.

*Greg Hetrick* recommended contacting 911 Center to contact Freedom Township Police for cardiac arrests when Greenfield Township Police are not on duty.

The Supervisors responded to all questions and comments.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:37 p.m. with a unanimous vote on the motion by Ray Benton (2<sup>nd</sup>, Vernon Walter).
