

ORDINANCE 2020-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GREENFIELD, COUNTY OF BLAIR, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2018-04, IN ORDER TO CHANGE FROM FIFTY FEET TO THIRTY FEET THE DISTANCE FROM WHICH CERTAIN OPEN FIRES MUST BE PLACED FROM A STRUCTURE WHEN LOCATED ON A RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Greenfield Township (hereinafter "Municipality"), and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: Greenfield Township Ordinance 2018-04, which regulates burning activities, hereby amended, particularly in Section 3, "Permitted Burning and Burning Times," to change from fifty feet to thirty feet the distance from which certain open fires must be placed from a structure when located on a residential property.

SECTION 2: More specifically, Section 3, subsection 1.d, in Ordinance 2018-04, shall be replaced in its entirety with the following:

1.
 - d. *Contained fires must be at least thirty (30) feet away from any building or structure;*

SECTION 3: Additionally, Section 3, subsection 2.e, in Ordinance 2018-04, shall be replaced in its entirety with the following:

2.
 - e. *Fire location must be greater than thirty (30) feet from any structure or road edge;*


SECTION 4: All other language in Section 3, and the remainder of Ordinance 2018-04, shall remain unchanged.




