POLICE REPORT

Chief Ron Sharkey gave the February 2021 police report.

Officer Dan Eastep requested solar motion lights installed at the park, especially at the playground area. Supervisor Treon will look into the matter.

Chief Sharkey requested VASCAR installed in his car. The kit will cost \$600.

Chief Sharkey requested masks with the township logo/name for all employees. On a motion by Matt Treon (2nd, Joe Claar), the Supervisors moved to purchase four (4) sets [24 total] of fabric masks with a total cost not to exceed \$80.

Roll Call Vote: Joe, Yes Matt, Yes Jordan, Yes Chief Sharkey asked the Board to purchase a new police car for \$58,000. The car's cost is \$32,706; in-car system, \$4,338.96; watch guard camera, \$5,775. The in-car system and watch guard camera cost would be saved [\$10,113.96] by using equipment from an existing vehicle. The Board requested a solid, firm, locked-in price with an estimate of the time to receive the vehicle and amount of time down one car. The Board did not take action on the matter.

The meeting adjourned at 7:30 pm with no further business with a unanimous vote on Matt Treon's motion (2nd, Joe Claar).
