

**Greenfield Township Supervisors  
Special Meeting  
March 26, 2021**

At the Greenfield Township building, the special meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Greenfield Township, Blair County, was called to order by Supervisor Matt Treon at 8:00 am. The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance.

**Present:** Supervisor Matthew Treon, Supervisor Jordan Oldham, Supervisor Joseph Claar, Chief Ronald Sharkey, Officer Dan Eastep, and Arlene Kuntz.

**Public Comments:**

- Officer Dan Eastep presented to the Board a rotation schedule for himself and Officer Sam McClure. The Board noted the schedule has 20 hours of overlap, only one shift per day on Saturday and Sunday, two shifts per day on Monday – Wednesday. The Board discussed their viewpoints of a police schedule with Officer Dan for 30 minutes.
- The Board commented on the COVID-10 Pandemic Protective Measures Memo issued to the police department.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**Jarrett Musselman Subdivision Plan – 1549 Everett Rd, East Freedom:** On a motion by Joe Claar (2<sup>nd</sup>, Matt Treon), the Supervisors granted the waiver from SALDO 403.b.2.b, regarding FEMA designation of the 100-yr floodplain boundaries.

**TriStar Motors Invoice #C21F661 for a police car and municipal upfitting:** On a motion by Matt Treon (2<sup>nd</sup>, Jordan Oldham), the Supervisors moved to pay invoice #C21F661 from TriStar Motors for a 2021 Ford Explorer AWD Interceptor with police municipal upfitting for \$45,334.05, a complete package.

**Jack White Studios Inc (No. 0002) \$575 for complete lettering on unit #840-1:** On a motion by Matt Treon (2<sup>nd</sup>, Jordan Oldham), the Supervisors moved to accept the quote for complete lettering on the new police vehicle #840-1 by Jack White Studios Inc for \$575. The Chief will have a quote for April 6, 2021, board meeting to remove the decommissioned vehicle's lettering.

**Transfer funds for police vehicle:** On a motion by Joe Claar (2<sup>nd</sup>, Jordan Oldham), the Supervisors authorized Arlene Kuntz, Treasurer, to transfer up to \$48,909.05 from the S&T Bank money market to the First Commonwealth Bank for the new police car.

The Board gave the following directives regarding the purchase of a police car:

- The new vehicle is to be at the township within two weeks. At this point, the old car will be out of commission, letters removed, and cannot be used.
- The Chief should be the primary driver of the new car. The Board did not stipulate who drives the vehicle; however, they stipulated many miles are not to be put on

the new vehicle. The new car will not be used for trips, i.e., to Greensburg with evidence.

- The lights from the old, decommissioned car will be kept for on the SRO vehicle. The Chief is to get a quote to have the lights installed on the SRO car.
- The Board wants all the cars to match. The Chief is to get a quote to have the other two vehicles lettered to match the new graphic.

The Board authorized Officer Eastep to get a monthly and yearly car wash quote from Sheetz and Claysburg Pizza.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 am with no further business with a unanimous vote on Matt Treon's motion (2<sup>nd</sup>, Joe Claar).
