Volunteer Firefighters Tax Credit, Act 172

- Volunteer firefighters need to be members of the Claysburg Volunteer Fire Company or Blue Knob Volunteer Fire Company.
- The Fire Chiefs discussed the eligibility criteria for the tax credit. To be eligible, the volunteer firefighter will need to participate in 30% of calls, 30% training, and 30% of fundraising events, all three.
- The tax credit is for 100% of municipal property tax and earned income tax, both.

The public hearing adjourned at 6:00 pm with a unanimous vote on the motion by Joe Claar.
