Minimum eligibility criteria for the Volunteer Firefighters Tax Credit Act 172 are as follows:

<b>Member</b>	Claysburg Volunteer Fire Company or Blue Knob Volunteer Fire Company
<b>Residency</b>	Greenfield Township, Blair County
<b>30%</b>	Participation in Emergency Response Calls
<b>30%</b>	Completion of certified training opportunities
<b>30%</b>	Participation in fundraising activities

The tax credit is 100% of municipal property tax and earned income tax collected by Greenfield Township, Blair County.

A notarized eligibility list of volunteers will be given to the Township from the Chief by January 31<sup>st</sup>. At the fire station, an eligibility list will be posted.

**The application, completed by the volunteer, is due to the Township Secretary no later than April 1<sup>st</sup>.**

The Board of Supervisors will approve the Official Tax Credit Register at a May public meeting.

Approved tax rebate checks will be issued no later than June 1<sup>st</sup>.

Applicants have the right to file an appeal within 30 days of a rejection claim.

If injured during an emergency response call and injury prevents participation, a volunteer may be eligible for tax credits.
