

**Greenfield Township Supervisors
Regular Meeting
March 1, 2022**

At the Greenfield Township building, the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Greenfield Township, Blair County, was called to order by Chairman Jordan Oldham at 6:30 pm. The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance.

2022-07 Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement (Second Amendment Sanctuary Referendum) : On a motion by Joe Claar (2nd, Alex Musselman), the Supervisors adopted Resolution 2022-07 to declare a second amendment sanctuary and prohibit the use of taxpayer resources to enforce any legislation passed after November 2, 2021, that would infringe upon an eligible citizen's right to bear arms.
